

Isolation Flowchart for Learners/Families

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE COVID-19 or COVID-19 like Symptoms, Regardless of Vaccination Status



- **Stay home for the next five days**, regardless of vaccination status, if you test positive for COVID-19 and/or have COVID-19 like symptoms [as described by the MDH and CDC](#).



- Stay away from other people as much as possible (including people in your own household)



- If you can't stay away from other people, wear a mask



After five days, do you still have a fever or other symptoms that haven't improved?



- Return to school/activities
- Wear a mask everywhere you go and social distance to the extent possible for next five days



- Stay home until your fever is gone and other symptoms are better
- Wear a mask around others to minimize exposure

Day of Positive Test for COVID-19

Return to School. Wear Mask 5 Days.



If you have symptoms of COVID-19 and are waiting for your test results, stay home until you get your test results.

Quarantine Flowchart for Learners/Families

WHAT TO DO IF SOMEONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAS COVID-19 or COVID-19 like Symptoms And You are NOT Vaccinated.



Quarantine keeps someone who was in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 away from others. (ref: CDC)

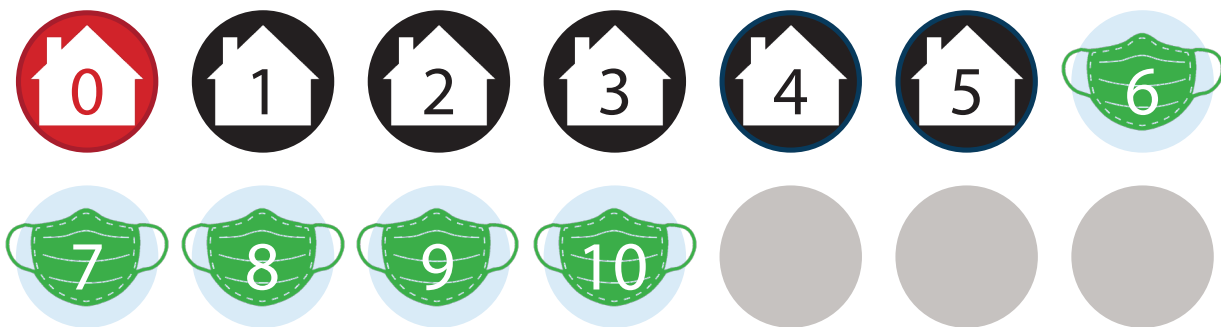
If you are unvaccinated

Learners who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days AND are symptom free are **not required** to quarantine.*

- Stay home for five days after your last exposure.
- **Wear a mask** around others for the next **five days**.
- If you develop symptoms or test positive, stay home and follow timeline on page 1.*

Day of Exposure to Positive Person in Household

If no symptoms, Return to School & Wear Mask for 5 Days



*If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the timeline on page 1. Stay home for 5 days. Then if symptoms improve and you have no fever for 24 hours, return to school.
